Monolith A

Monolith A is composed of three oblique structures rising vertically through the main lobby. The three structures are meant to represent the three pillars of the land-grant mission of the Division of Agricultural and Natural Resources at Oklahoma State University: Research, Teaching, and Extension. As you walk around the Monolith, its perspective changes as it is viewed from different locations. This monolith conveys the need to explore as the ever-changing world evolves.

The University wants to introduce an entry experience for the New Frontiers building, one that will produce a “wow” factor when entering the front door and create a memorable experience that evokes thought and contemplation for those using and visiting the facility. Therefore, an artistic element referred to as a Monolith is being proposed for the main lobby of New Frontiers to achieve these goals.

The Monolith is located near the Dairy Bar. It rises through the two-story lobby penetrating the ceiling of the second floor and can be seen continuing on the third floor. The monolith is a strong wayfinding element for the building letting everyone know exactly where they are when they see it.

Two different monolith designs are being considered for the lobby of the building. Both have similar features, both are colored America’s Brightest Orange, yet both are different in their design. Each one has a different conceptual meaning behind their creation.
