** All landscape architecture students are required to complete a summer internship, LA 3010: Landscape Architecture Internship for a 1 credit. Students that are on-track or ahead of schedule have the option to complete a long-term internship during the spring and summer semesters of the 3rd year or the summer and fall semester of their 4th year. Students enrolled in the long-term internship (6 to 7 months in duration), LA 3020 for 5 credits can substitute the internship for LA 4515 or LA 3525. Students interested in the long-term internship options should talk with their advisor.
